Application for courses, **made on or before the course application deadline**, addressed to the Senior Assistant Registrar-Student Recruitment and Admissions, should be made on **official course application coupons** available at the University & in the newspaper advertisement accompanied by copies of **ACADEMIC and/or PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES; copy of NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD or WAITING SLIP or PASSPORT; and a BANK DEPOSIT SLIP; or a BANKERS' CHEQUE; or a POSTAL MONEY ORDER** made payable to the University College of a **NON-REFUNDABLE COURSE APPLICATION FEE of Kshs 2,000/=**
