Intake: April and August (Apply in March & July)

Duration: 8 weeks

Mode: 2 days a week-Monday & Wednesday (4.00-7.00p.m.)

Minimum entry qualifications: Any interested persons for leisure, domestic or commercial. Any formal academic certificates qualify as entry requirements

Other Requirements: Kitchen uniforms, tea cloths, dish cloth, icing kit and cake decoration tools purchased through the department

Tuition Fees: Kshs.20,000/=

2) Basic Cake Making & Decoration (non-examinable)

Intake: April and August (Apply in March & July)

Duration: 8 weeks

Mode: 2 days a week-Tuesday & Wednesday (4.00-7.00p.m.)

Minimum entry qualifications: Any interested persons for leisure, domestic or commercial. Any formal academic certificates qualify as entry requirements

Other Requirements: Kitchen uniforms, tea cloths, dish cloth, icing kit and cake decoration tools purchased through the department

Tuition Fees: Kshs.20,000/=

3) Advanced Cake Making & Decoration (non-examinable)

Mode: 1 day a week-Wednesday (4.00-7.00p.m.)

Intake: April and August (Apply in March & July)

Duration: 10 weeks

Minimum entry qualifications: Basic cake making & Decoration certificate

Other Requirements: Kitchen uniforms, tea cloths, dish cloth, icing kit and cake decoration tools purchased through the department

Tuition Fees: Kshs. 20,000/=

4) Advanced Confectionery

Intake: April and August & December (Apply in March, July & October)

Duration: 6 weeks

Minimum entry qualifications: Basic Confectionery certificate

Tuition Fees: Kshs. 20,000/=

Applications for courses are available only when courses have been advertised in the daily newspapers and should be made during the official application period following the course advertisement. Application for courses, **made on or before the course application deadline**, addressed to the Senior Assistant Registrar-Student Recruitment and Admissions, should be made on **official course application coupons** available at the University & in the newspaper advertisement accompanied by copies of **ACADEMIC and/or PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES; copy of NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD or WAITING SLIP or PASSPORT; and a BANK DEPOSIT SLIP; or a BANKERS' CHEQUE; or a POSTAL MONEY ORDER** made payable to the University College of a **NON-REFUNDABLE COURSE APPLICATION FEE of Kshs 2,000/=**
