INTRODUCTION

Lake Victoria Ecosystem is threatened by various pollutants that originate from anthropogenic activities within its catchment and in particular along its shoreline. Some of the problems facing the lake basin are seen in the significant change in water quality which has resulted in rapid decline in fish and bird population as well as changes in species diversity and abundance. Similar pollution problems have been experienced in the Three Gorges Reservoir (TGR), China, a large water body, the largest in East Asia, which is supporting a large human population but impounded recently in contrast to Lake Victoria. Some of the experiences observed and the achievements already made in terms of pollution abatement, flood control, human resettlement, agriculture and tourism in TGR can provide bench marks for sustainable development of large water resources such as Lake Victoria. This workshop will bring together various researchers and other stakeholders of diverse backgrounds from all countries worldwide including Germany, China, Kenya, Uganda and Tanzania, to deliberate on freshwater pollution impacts and mitigation processes needed for sustainable socio-economic development and ecosystem health management in the Lake Victoria catchment.

Objective

To collate data and comparative information towards mitigation of pollution problems and sustainable management of Lake Victoria and Three Gorges Reservoir
