

THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF KENYA

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Foundations

Technical University of Kenya shares history with the development of the first three higher educational institutions in East Africa. The 1920s saw agitation for expansion of access to higher education by indigenous leaders in the East African Territories. Concerted efforts were put in place in form of committees, commissions and conferences which saw the elevation of Makerere Technical Institute to Makerere University College of the University of London in 1949, proposal to establish the Royal Technical College (RTC) in Nairobi which came to fruition with start of construction on 25th January 1952 and the establishment of Dar es Salaam University College in 1961.

The RTC in Nairobi opened its doors to the first students pursuing Architecture, Arts, Domestic Science, and Engineering and Science in April 1956. The first students to Kenya Technical Institute (now the Technical University of Kenya) were also admitted in 1956 in the tuition facilities of RTC Nairobi. The government of Kenya then developed Kenya Technical Institute at its present site in three phases. The first phase 1957-1958 comprised planning and working drawing followed by construction of administration block, tuition block and supply of equipment in the period 1958-1959. The third phase, 1959-1960 covered construction of laboratory wing, workshops, roads and site work and supply of equipment. The Kenya Technical Institute started operating on its new site from 1st January 1961 but was officially opened on 29th May 1961. It was later renamed as the Kenya Polytechnic.

The Kenya Polytechnic

Subsequently the Kenya Polytechnic was registered by the Ministry of Education as a post-secondary educational institution on 18th January 1967 with the registration number 12715 and with the provision to carry a maximum of 2,075 students. Over the years the Polytechnic experienced great expansion in terms of student numbers, diversity of academic programmes and in general scope of operations. From its founding, the Kenya Polytechnic quickly established itself as a centre of excellence in the training of middle level manpower in the country. This function, the Polytechnic has carried with great admiration as testified by the recognition and respect that her graduates have continued to enjoy in the employment market.

The Kenya Polytechnic had been established with the principal objective to train largely in the technical fields, especially engineering, architecture, surveying, and planning. The training in these fields would essentially be supported by programmes in the sciences, especially mathematics, physics, chemistry, and biology. From this, the scope of the subjects offered at the Polytechnic was expanded to include other vocational subjects such as business studies and management, hospitality and hotel management, health sciences and technology, and design and printing. Also in the 1970's computer science and information technology was introduced as a major area of study at the institution. Over the years it was recognised that even those trained in the technical fields needed to be exposed to social skills that would enable them to interface the technical knowledge with the practical needs of society. Consequently courses in such areas such as communications and general liberal studies were introduced.

The University College

In the year 2005 the Government of Kenya launched the Sessional Paper No. 1 – A Policy Framework for Education, Training, and Research. The Sessional Paper provided for the upgrading of national polytechnics to offer degree programmes in their areas of expertise. The upgrading was under the special proviso that the polytechnics would however continue to offer their traditional tertiary programmes. Thus the polytechnics were to continue offering education and training at the Diploma level and to continue with the training of middle level manpower. The Sessional Paper in particular provided for educational and training path for candidates who have developed through the Technical, and Vocational Educational and Training (TVET) programme. Within this framework, the polytechnics would be expected to provide leadership in the TVET and act as the apex of technical and vocational education and training.

The process of upgrading the Polytechnic was initiated by the Ministry of Education immediately after the launch of the Sessional Paper in 2005. The Ministry then formed a committee to oversee this process. After much consideration it was decided that the best way forward in establishing the institution as degree awarding institution was through the establishment of the institution as a university college. It was further decided that as a university college the institution shall be a constituent college of the University of Nairobi. On 23rd August 2007 the President of the Republic of Kenya signed the Kenya Polytechnic University College Legal Order thereby formally establishing the Kenya Polytechnic University College as a constituent college of the University of Nairobi. Although the college was established with effect from August 2007, it did not begin to function as a university college until November 2008 when the Principal for the university college had been appointed.

In July 2009, the university college had the first batch of the programmes of study approved by the Senate at the University of Nairobi. The curricula were in the area of electrical and electronic engineering and comprised the Bachelor of Engineering (B.Eng.) in Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) in Electrical and Electronic Engineering Technology), and the Diploma in Technology (Dip.Tech.) in Electrical and Electronic Engineering Technology. The programmes were designed to cover respectively five, four, and three years of study for the B.Eng., B.Tech., and Dip.Tech. The first cohort of degree students joined the college in January 2009.

The University

In the year 2012, the Commission of University Education formally informed the Kenya Polytechnic of the plans for inspection in line with requirements of to a fully fledged university under the present Universities Act. The institution was inspected on 24th February 2012. The inspection was successful and on 15th January 2013, the institution was awarded Charter by His Excellency, Hon Mwai Kibaki, the then President of the Republic of Kenya, to become the Technical University of Kenya.

Business Enterprises and Services

The University engages in sophisticated consultancy services as a way of supporting the private sector, generating scholarship for students and faculty members and gearing towards self sufficiency.

Networks, Partnerships and Linkages

TUK has established frameworks for collaborative engagements with industry, research and peer institutions. The partnership are both horizontal for knowledge sharing as well as vertical for knowledge and skills transfer, through mentorship of lower technical institution and technology transfer from motivation centres to the community. Through the establish strong links with industry opportunities are created for students to acquire industrial experience while still on campus and at the same time enable members of staff to acquire practical experience which they can then share with the student in the classroom.
