For New Students Placed by KUCCPS in the 2025/2026 Placement Cycle

You are required to:

- Visit the University website and navigate to Portals > New Students' 1. Registration.
- 2. Enter your index number to re-download your admission letter, which now reflects the updated Semester I Fee amounts as provided by the Higher Education Financing (HEF).
- Pay the updated semester fees. The Admissions Office will then process your 3. registration to completion. Only after full registration will you be able to access University services, including application for accommodation.

Important Notes:

- Ensure you have downloaded the latest version of your admission letter before proceeding.
- If your revised admission letter does not reflect the updated fee amounts, you must immediately apply for funding via the HEF Student Portal.
- Failure to apply for funding will result in payment of full tuition fees (without Government subsidy) plus additional charges.

For Continuing Students (Government HELB & Scholarship Beneficiaries)

This serves as a reminder that all continuing students benefiting from government HELB and Scholarships must reapply for funding for the 2025/2026 academic year.
