The 15th Graduation Ceremony

Second Cohort of the 2025 Class

The Technical University of Kenya will hold its 15th Graduation Ceremony on **Tuesday, 31st March 2026 at 8:30 a.m.**

Graduands are required to attend in person. Parents, guardians, relatives, and friends may view the live stream via the University website (www.tukenya.ac.ke) and official social media platforms (YouTube, X, and Facebook).

I. Eligibility and Clearance

Graduation status, as approved by the University Senate, is available on the Student Portal.

To be cleared for graduation by **Friday, 20th March 2026**, students must:

- Complete all academic requirements.
- Clear all outstanding fee balances.
- Complete the online clearance process via the Student Portal (<https://portal.tukenya.ac.ke>) and print the final “**Graduation Certificate.**”

Students who missed previous ceremonies must initiate the “**Alternative Reinstatement**” process through the Student Portal and complete clearance by the deadline.

II. Graduation Fees

All graduands must pay a non-refundable convocation fee by **Friday, 20th March 2026**:

Level of Award	Fee (KSh)
Certificate, Diploma, and Bachelor's	5,000.00
Postgraduate	6,500.00

III. Academic Regalia

Regalia will be issued only to cleared graduands who have printed their final “Graduation Certificate” by **Friday, 20th March 2026**.

- **Collection:** Thursday, 26th – Friday, 27th March 2026 from respective Department Chairs’ offices.
- **Return:** On or before Monday, 6th April 2026.
- **Late Return Penalty:** KSh 100 per day.

IV. Graduation Rehearsal

Attendance at the graduation rehearsal is **compulsory** for all graduands participating in the ceremony.

- **Date:** Monday, 30th March 2026
- **Time:** 10:00 a.m. (All participants must be seated by 9:00 a.m.)
- **Dress Code:** Full academic attire

V. Verification of Names

Names will appear on graduation certificates exactly as recorded in the original admission documents. Graduands **MUST** confirm the correct spelling and order of their names during the clearance process.

The University will not be responsible for errors that are not reported and corrected before the deadline.
