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NOTICE ON IMPLEMENTATION OF THE HOUSEHOLD STUDENT FEE STATEMENT SYSTEM

Date: 26th January, 2026

1. Following a Government directive dated **30th July, 2025**, all Public Universities adopted a harmonised tuition fee structure under the **Student-Centred Funding Model**, effective **1st September, 2025**. The Technical University of Kenya implemented this structure at the commencement of the September, 2025 Semester and invoiced all students accordingly.
2. Due to delays in the disbursement of Government scholarships and loans, some student portals temporarily reflected balances exceeding the approved household contribution. To enhance clarity, the University has ensured that Government-sponsored students are issued fee statements reflecting only the household contribution, in accordance with the Government-prescribed household contribution limits.
3. Government-sponsored students are therefore required to access their fee statements (invoices) through their respective student portals and settle the invoiced household contribution.
4. Students who are not beneficiaries of Government funding shall pay the full harmonised tuition fee for their respective programmes, as invoiced on the student portal.
5. All students are reminded that eligibility to sit for the examinations is subject to compliance with the following requirements:
 - i. Signing of the Nominal Roll;
 - ii. Attendance of not less than 75% of the total contact hours for each prescribed course unit; and
 - iii. Clearance of all outstanding fee balances.
