Suspension of Remaining Examinations Scheduled for 25th May, 2026

The University Senate regrets to inform all students that, due to disruption of examinations by a few students today, all examinations scheduled for today at 11.00 a.m., 2.00 p.m., and 4.00 p.m. that had not commenced or had not been completed stand suspended.

Students are further informed that all examinations scheduled for 26th May, 2026 onwards shall proceed as per the approved examination timetable. The University has put in place enhanced security measures to ensure that examinations are conducted in a peaceful, orderly, and secure environment.

All eligible students are therefore advised to:

- i. Report for their examinations on time;
- ii. Carry valid examination identification documents, including validated examination cards;
- iii. Observe University rules and examination regulations at all times; and
- iv. Cooperate fully with University security personnel and invigilators.

Any student **WHO WILL** attempt to disrupt examinations **SHALL** face severe disciplinary action in accordance with University regulations. The suspended examinations will be rescheduled for 10th June, 2026.

Students who had not cleared fees by the deadline of 6.00 p.m. on Sunday, 24th May, 2026, will be eligible to sit for Special Examinations scheduled for August 2026, subject to fulfilment of all University requirements.
