PROFESSIONAL TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE FINAL YEAR STUDENTS AND RECENT GRADUATES OF THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF KENYA

In response to the growing economic and trade cooperation between China and Kenya, and in support of agricultural modernization in Kenya, Kaishan Terra Green Ammonia Company in collaboration with the Technical University of Kenya hereby invites applications from qualified recent graduates and final year students for a Special Professional Training Programme in China. Kaishan Terra Green Ammonia Company, established by Kaishan Group Co., Ltd. is currently constructing Kenya's first Green Fertilizer Plant at Olkaria, Naivasha with an annual output of approximately 480,000 tonnes. The construction was officially launched by His Excellency President William Ruto on 3rd November 2025.

Selected candidates will undertake approximately one (1) year of Mandarin language studies and technical professional training, at selected universities in China. The training will involve 2 batches of trainees (**Batch 1: April 2026 - March 2027 and Batch 2: July 2026 – May 2027**). Upon successful completion of the training, candidates will form part of the workforce for the Green Fertilizer Plant, which is expected to commence operations in mid-2027.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be:

- Kenyan citizens.
- Recent Graduates of the Technical University of Kenya (Batch 1).
- Final year students and those expecting to graduate in 2026 (Batch 2).
- Holders of a Bachelor's degree in **Chemical Engineering, Electrical & Electronic Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Industrial Chemistry**.
