1. TUTORIAL FELLOW (REF/NO. AC/0004/13)

Successful candidates will be expected to pursue further training and attain higher degrees in their respective areas of specialization, and participate in research activities.

They will be expected to undertake some teaching assignments at the undergraduate level as well as participate in other activities of the Department, School, and University.
